# 1014 Safety Guidance



## **Using the Diesel Generator**

- Keep a close check on any cables that are being used especially extension cables. If they appear to be damaged in any way, stop the generator and replace
- The generator has fuses or circuit breakers to protect it in case of overload. If a fuse appears to have blown, ensure a competent person replaces it.
- The generator may switch itself off if it gets too hot. Allow it to cool down before restarting. If this happens repeatedly, check with a competent person or the hire company.
- Stop the generator before leaving it unattended.
- If the equipment does not work properly, do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.

## **Diesel Generator**

#### Read this entire leaflet before using the Diesel Generator

- Plan the use of the generator so that it can always be used safely.
- A competent person must authorise use of the generator for some of the applications outlined in this leaflet.
- The services of a qualified electrician will be required if the generator is to be used to supply an installed or large system, or for some of the other uses outlined in this leaflet.
- 4. Electricity is dangerous and must always be used with great
- Diesel is highly flammable. Take care not to cause a fire or explosion.
- This equipment is designed to generate electricity up to its rated current, at its rated
- The action of this generator can cause injury or damage if the equipment is not used in a careful and controlled way.
- If you have not used a generator before, and you plan to connect the generator to anything other than a single tool or appliance, ensure a competent person checks that what you are doing is safe.
- The following items of personal protective equipment are a minimum: Ear defenders or plugs giving protection for levels up to 85dB(A);
- 10. This generator must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs
- 11. This generator is designed for operation by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.
